

The New Brunswick Middle School Robotics Team attended the FIRST LEGO Animal Allies Challenge Competition which was based on a real-world scientific topic at Hillsborough High School on Saturday, November 19, 2016.

Each Challenge of the competition had four parts: [1] Robot Game, [2] Project, [3] Robot Design and [4] Core Values. Twenty-six teams participated in the Challenge by programming a robot to score points on a themed playing field (Robot Game), developing a solution to a problem they have identified (Project), and designing a robot to complete various missions on the game table (Robot Design).

Throughout these events, students were guided by the FIRST LEGO League Core Values (Core Values).

The New Brunswick Middle School Robotics Team won the 2016 Presentation Award for the Presentation of their scientific solution to a problem that they identified that exists between Animals and Humans. This award recognizes a team that effectively communicated the problem that they have identified and clearly proposed their solution to both the judges and other potential supporters.

The Team also placed 4th out of 26 teams on the Robot Game Field.
