## 2017-2018 NBPS RECYCLING PROGRAM

This is a reminder that recycling is mandated in all schools by state law. More importantly, the New Brunswick Board of Education is committed to protecting the environment and recycling plays a major role in that commitment. Working with Building Administrators, our recycling efforts will continuously be monitored and we will take appropriate action to improve compliance as needed.

Recycling is easier than ever with single stream recycling allowing schools to mix bottles, cans, paper and cardboard in one recycling bin. Just drop bottles, cans, and paper in the blue recycle bin in your classroom.

Recycle plastic containers marked with the #1 or #2 recycling symbol only. All other plastic containers should be treated as trash.

Any paper you can easily tear should be recycled including school paper, envelopes, chip board (from tissue boxes & note pads), colored paper, soft cover books and more.

Place large corrugated cardboard boxes neatly stacked near the doorway. Your custodial staff will take care of collection.

Be sure to keep recyclables separate from trash. Please inform and instruct all students so they can recycle correctly in school.
